

Case Law/Legal Update Q&A Follow-Up:

Is it okay to end your final letter by asking a requestor to respond immediately if there is a document they were expecting to receive that wasn't included with the documents provided?

It is good to include but won't be a silver bullet to defeat a lawsuit. But it will sometimes prompt a requestor to tell you what was missing.

Does your third-party notification practice to a court reporter apply to deposition transcripts?

Yes

How would Does v King affect ongoing PRR's that include documents where there wasn't a finding a sexual harassment?

probably not -- the courts have recognized that claims involving sex are particularly stigmatizing.

Does this create a duty of a sheriff's office to research what action the prosecutor took in a case? We are two separate agencies under Koenig...

Unfortunately yes -- which is one of the reasons why there should be a discussion, given this case is not binding.
